# Hello founders and friends,


It has been an exciting year for the Czech startup community, despite facing challenges such as unprovoked Russian aggression on Ukraine, post-COVID supply chain disruptions, and high inflation. Our research shows that founders raised over \$1.5 billion in venture capital rounds, representing a 64% growth compared to 2021 and 10 times more than three years ago. We now have four Czech tech companies with valuations exceeding \$1 billion, with one startup achieving unicorn status in 2022. Additionally, there were 14 startup exits and 110 funding rounds in 2022, and startups attracted over half a million job applicants in the last ten years.

However, we recognize that there are still challenges to be addressed in order to continue this growth, such as outdated employment and visa policies, limited access to pre-seed capital, and a lack of entrepreneurial education at all levels. Our community has grown significantly, with 226 new members and a total of 765 members, making it the largest startup community in the country. We have also organized eight events, conducted three community-wide surveys, and launched four new initiatives, including a venture capital firm for early-stage startups.

We are grateful for the support and efforts of the entire startup ecosystem, including government officials and startup fans, to make the Czech founders' community a thriving and successful one. We look forward to continuing to grow and support each other in 2023.





## BACK TO THE FUTURE

After New Year's Eve of 2021, we conducted a survey among **Czech startup founders** to assess their progress in the past year and their expectations for 2022. Despite the challenges posed by the COVID-19 pandemic, eight out of ten respondents expected 2022 to be even better than the previous year, with none expecting it to be worse. We conducted a **similar survey early in January 2023**, and the results are as follows:

of founders stayed with their startup

Overall, they saw 2022 as a very good year (7.4 out of 10) with almost no change from the previous year.

14%

of founders reported a decline in employment in their status (compared to 11% the previous year).

of startups grew in 2022

(down by 11%), with 5 in 10 growing more than 200%.

Twice as many founders reported no growth in 2022 compared to the previous year (16% vs. 6.6%). 11% of startups reported a decline in revenues.

Czech founders expect less recruitment this year and their focus has shifted from hiring to managing existing employees, compared to the previous year.



In February, we created the **Czech Founders Mastermind** – a program that brings together startup CEOs to share their challenges, learn from each other's experiences, and gain inspiration to keep pushing forward. We carefully select participants based on their skills, expertise, and level of seniority, and place them in small groups of like-minded individuals who meet regularly to share, brainstorm, and learn from each other. These small groups act as a personal advisory board for each member.

In 2022, we formed three groups with up to seven members, each led by a volunteer team leader (also a founder). Members pay a monthly fee to participate. In 2023, we plan to enroll more members from our growing waiting list of applicants.



## SHARING THE SECRETS

**Founders** Festival #3 The **Founders Festival**, an education event for startup founders and experts, was launched during the COVID-19 pandemic to provide a platform for sharing knowledge and expertise. The festival featured a series of workshops led by successful founders and partners, offering practical advice and opportunities for discussion. In March. 12 workshops were held on topics such as expanding to foreign markets, negotiating

term sheets, and hiring key personnel. Attendees were carefully selected from our community to ensure relevance, and participated in exchange for a fee. Workshop leaders donated their time and expertise pro bono to give back to the startup community. The festival ended with a party attended by 100 founders. Additionally, we donated 60,000 CZK to support Ukraine in their defense efforts.


## Data for better decisions





## YOU ASKED FOR IT



In a survey of 140 founders conducted in 2021, we asked what the biggest struggle for early-stage startups was in getting the capital for kick-starting their venture. Founders confirmed there was a lack of professional investors eager to fund startups at the pre-revenue stage. Those that did invest early often offered predatory terms (taking too much equity, insisting on too much oversight, etc.) and did not help startups in their next fundraising efforts. So we decided to do something about it.

We launched the **Czech Founders VC**, a venture capital firm dedicated to Czech super early-stage startups. Run by founders for founders. Backed by over 45 accomplished founders of businesses such as Productboard, Mews, Livesport, CDN77, Ytica, Bohemia Interactive, and many others who actively contribute to deal sourcing, deal selection, and portfolio support. With EUR10M Fund I., we have already invested in four startups in 2022, with many more in the pipeline.

efforts.




#### **Launching Czech Founders Masterclass**







